Benefits of attending the course

Cognitive rehabilitation following acquired brain injury is about techniques and practices that help to promote the restoration of cognitive skills such as memory or planning skills through retraining the disrupted skill or by teaching the use of compensatory strategies to 'by-pass' the disrupted skill. In reality, most cognitive rehabilitation is a combination of both approaches.

In this course, you will look at the early phase rehabilitation approaches following brain injury (quite often hospital-based) and also at what might be possible in terms of long-term community-based rehabilitation. In this course, however you will primarily focus on community-based rehabilitation practice and the issues to take into account when designing a cognitive rehabilitation programme for an individual client.
