It was an excellent and, at times, emotional morning that aimed to show our relatives and carers how much of a vital role they play in their loved ones journey and how much of an incredible job they are doing. The morning finished with a question and answer session that allowed a chance to share stories and offer peer support.

The afternoon consisted of a marketplace of professionals providing excellent information and advice. SOUTH HUB - 'BRAIN INJURY & ME' PROGRAMME 2023



The South Essex hub in Benfleet completed a second successful Brain Injury and Me programme of the year. The programme runs for 3 hourly sessions across 8 weeks and includes topics on:-Brain Anatomy; Concentration & Attention; Memory; Different Functions of the Brain; Emotional Consequences.

The programme is packed full of informative and useful information for our clients and their families, information that in some instances they have never been told about. It combines an aspect of learning about the brain injury from a practical perspective as well as individual topics such as issues with attention, memory, fatigue, emotion to name just a few.

The most powerful take away for many of the people that attend the programme is that feeling of not being on their own, having the opportunity to talk about some serious things but with an element of comfort and peer support......and some amazing humour! It is the people who attend the group and share their own personal experiences which makes the programme so valuable.
